* Tennessee conducts concurrent visits for initial accreditation and joint visits for continuing accreditation. Both concurrent and joint team composition for Tennessee is accounted for in the totals.

Partnership Type: The two-way partnership is between NCATE and the State Department of Education or the State Board of Teaching; the three way partnership also includes the state’s higher education commission. In the case of CO, the partnership is only between NCATE and the state higher education commission.

Team Composition: The team may be all NCATE Board of Examiner members and a state “consultant” (from the state agency); a joint team includes both NCATE BOE and trained state reviewers who work together to conduct the review and make decisions; concurrent teams refer to a state team and an NCATE team that work at the same time, (and may share information), but make independent decisions about the standards.

Program Review: The state may delegate the program review to NCATE and use the findings for its state approval process; or, NCATE may defer to the state’s review if the state adopts NCATE program standards or if the state develops program standards that closely align with NCATE program standards and conducts a program review similar to the NCATE program review.

NCATE or National Accreditation Required: While NCATE accreditation is voluntary, some states mandate NCATE or national accreditation of its teacher education institutions.

All Public Institutions NCATE Accredited: Some states mandate NCATE or national accreditation of its public teacher education institutions. In some cases all public institutions are NCATE accredited even if there is no mandate.
